Our uniform policy has been designed to promote a positive and safe learning environment characterized by high levels of student joy and engagement and few instances of negative discipline infractions.

We expect students to adhere to the dress code every day*. Students who are out of dress code will be sent to an Administrator's office to call a family member to bring the required dress code items. If a family member is not available, the student will not be allowed to attend class, and the student may also receive a disciplinary consequence for violating the schools dress code policy.

Bottoms: **Do NOT have to be purchased through AllUniformWear**

- KIPP Jacksonville Elementary and KIPP VOICE Elementary must wear tan khakis
- KIPP Impact Middle must wear tan or navy blue khakis

Additional Information:

• **Accessories & Jewelry:**

- Minimal jewelry is allowed. Jewelry cannot make noise, be visually distracting, or pose a risk to others in play.
- No hats or bandanas, including bandana bows, are to be worn or brought to school.

• **Bottoms:**

- Khaki pants, shorts, or skirts are allowed (however, shorts and skirts must be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee and should not be too baggy or too tight). Pants may not be rolled, past cuffing.
- Khaki jumpers are not allowed.
- Tights, leggings, jeggings, yoga pants, or any style of skin-tight pants are NOT allowed under any circumstance, including dress down days. However, these tight pants can be worn only if they are a solid neutral color underneath a khaki skirt.
- Jeans, or any sort of denim, are not allowed.
- Belt must be worn daily (unless the bottoms do not have belt loops)

- **Cold Weather:** On very cold days, students may need to wear outerwear over their uniform on the way to and from school. However, any clothing that does not meet the dress code requirements must be removed immediately after entering the building.

- **Old Uniforms:** Students are NOT allowed to wear uniform tops from before 2016-2017, because older items are not the correct color and/or do not have the most up to date logo.

- **Shoes:** Athletic sneakers with laces that are tied or have Velcro in the front must be worn every day. Shoes and socks must have appropriate designs. No boots, high heels, loafers, boat shoes, ballet flats, flip flops or sandals are allowed.

*We will allow reasonable uniform accommodations based on a student's religion, disability, or medical condition. Requests for accommodations must be submitted in writing to the School Leader.
