2020-21 Academic School Year Uniform and Dress Code

At KIPP Public Schools Jacksonville, we believe that each classroom should be characterized by a loving culture and welcoming climate with a sense of community. We appreciate the talents and strengths of each individual, and we also value the strength and camaraderie that comes from being a unified KIPP team and family. Our uniform policy has been designed to promote a positive and safe learning environment characterized by high levels of student joy and engagement and few instances of negative discipline infractions.

We expect students to adhere to the dress code every day*. Students who are out of dress code will be sent to an Administrator's office to call a family member to bring the required dress code items. If a family member is not available, the student will not be allowed to attend class, and the student may also receive a disciplinary consequence for violating the schools dress code policy.

**We will allow reasonable uniform accommodations based on a student's religion, disability, or medical condition. Requests for accommodations must be submitted in writing to the Dean of School Operations.*

- **Outerwear:** On cold days, students may need to wear outerwear over their uniform on the way to and from school. However, any clothing or outerwear that does not meet the dress code requirements must be removed after entering the building. The following optional purchases are able to be worn over the polo throughout the day Any plain navy blue outerwear, not from Custom Shirts & Uniforms, will also be permitted.

- **Optional Purchase:** Navy Blue Fleece Jackets or Navy Blue Cardigan Sweater with KIPP logo

- If you purchase outerwear from Custom Shirts & Uniforms, they can embroider your student's name on the jacket or sweater at an additional cost. While highly recommended for tracking purposes, it is not required.



- **NEW Optional Purchase:** Navy Blue Crew Neck Sweatshirt with KIPP logo
(Must be worn with polo)

- **Bottoms:**

- Do not have to be purchased through Custom Shirts & Uniforms.
- All khakis must be tan or navy blue.
- Khaki pants, shorts, or skirts are allowed (however, shorts and skirts must be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee and should not be too baggy or too tight). Pants may not be rolled, past cuffing.
- Jumpers are not allowed.
- Tights, leggings, jeggings, yoga pants, or any style of skin-tight pants are not allowed unless worn underneath a khaki skirt; when doing so they must be a solid neutral color.
- Jeans, or any sort of denim, are not allowed.
- Belt should be worn daily (unless the bottoms do not have belt loops).

- **Shoes & Socks:**

- Athletic sneakers with laces or Velcro must be worn every day.
- Shoes and socks must have appropriate designs.
- No boots, high heels, loafers, boat shoes, ballet flats, flip flops or sandals are allowed.

- **Accessories & Jewelry:**

- Minimal jewelry is allowed. Jewelry cannot make noise, be visually distracting, or pose a safety risk to others.
- No hats or bandanas, including bandana bows, are to be worn or brought to school.
